Newport, Dec. 3^d 1798

Sir

The stamp masters ought to be directed that the paper which they furnish with the stamps should be of a good quality, such as Merchants generally use & such as may be suitable for the use intended and that people may not be confined to the stamp masters choice of paper, they should have such paper stamp'd, printed, or not, as they may think proper & if a quize, or more, he should return them therefor. Such paper as he ordinarily furnishes with stamps, these hints I conceive will be sufficient to refresh your memory with the conversation had with you relative to this subject.
