M. Samuel Lazarus having this day presented me an order signed by you for a stove and pipe said to be in my posession. I must, in my turn, inform you that I wrote a letter of the 13 Jus. to the President and Trustees of K. K. Shearith Israel (of which you are a member) informing I had a demand against that body for a room furnished by me for the purpose of teaching the children belonging to your Congregation, which yet remains unanswer'd. I now berewith transmitt you the account in hopes it may be settled without any altercation.
