Sir:

It is at request of my son Ben. Seixas that I presume to trouble you with this, to

acquaint you that he has informed his mother and myself that he has a very great regard

for your daughter, Miss Ziporah Levy, and should think himself very happy if he could

obtain your consent and approbation, as well as your amiable sponse's and all others

connected with the young lady, in permetting him soon to be joined to her in the sacred

bonds of matrimony.

We have no manner of objection there to and most sincerely wish it may meet with

your parental approbation, and that it may prove a source of joy and happiness to all our

families. I hope this may find you, good Mrs. Levy, all the children and conections

enjoying perfect health. Mrs. Seixas and all our family join with me in our most
