New York, June 20th 1769

Sir,

I begg leave to take this opportunity of my son's going that way to pay you my & all my family's compliments of congratulation on the happy nuptialls of Miss Symons with our worthy friend M.^r Michael Graatz, we sincerely [wish] you, & Mrs. Symons & all the family joy on the happy occasion, & pray the Almighty may grant them his sacred blessing, & holy protection, and that they may live happy & be a comfort to your old age.

Permit me, S^r, to recomend my son to your particular notice, he has never been so far from home, & if you find anything amiss in his behaviour, impute it favourably to his want of experience, & kindly admonish him for it, & excuse my freedom, our old acquaintance is my only apology: all my family beggs to be kindly remembered to M^{TS}. Symons. I humbly take my leave, & remain.
