Therefore, Administration is hereby granted him, fully impowering him the said Moses Seixas to act and do all Things needful and necessary in the Law for performing the Office and Duty of an Administrator of the personal Estate of the said Isaac Mendes Seixas, dece'd, of which he shall render an Account to the Court of Probate for the City aforesaid, within twelve months after the date hereof, in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my name and caused the Seal of the Court aforesaid to be affixed the day & year aforesaid, and in the tenth year of American Independency.
